1 st month	Stables Maintenance –	Workplace safety – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Able to follow the workplace safety and health system, safe work procedures implemented at the stables - Able to identify unsafe and negligent act that may endanger himself or others working in the stables Types of bedding – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Usage and Methods - Able to identify the different types of stable beddings and adopt the correct usage method. Types of tools & equipments – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Able to identify the different type of tools and equipments Daily routines – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mucking out and stall cleanliness - Able to demonstrate the ability to muck out and maintain cleanliness of stable stall and minimize the wastage of bedding. Weekly routines – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Top ups and lay out - Able to use the correct amount of bedding for topping and laying out a stall and demonstrate the ability to layout a stall efficiently. Monthly maintenance and clean out of stalls – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Able to demonstrate the ability to clean out a stall and layout with fresh bedding
2 nd month	Getting acquainted with Race horses –	Types of equipment – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bits, bridle, head collars - Able to demonstrate the ability to put on a bridle for a horse. Walking and handling of horses – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Control - Able to demonstrate the ability to walk and handle a horse with confidence. Turning out of horses – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Yards, paddocks, rolling boxes - Able to turnout a horse safely in the yard.
